- Each participant in the WBY Exposure Camp receives a 2012-13 edition of the WBY mailed to their home.

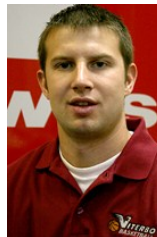
# Camp Staff
