



Scott Pirnstill is in his third season at the helm of the V-Hawk women's soccer program. During Pirnstill's second season, Viterbo finished 8–9 overall and 5–3 in the very competitive Midwest Collegiate Conference. The V-Hawks earned the fourth seed in the conference tournament but lost to Grand View University in the quarter-finals. Although the V-Hawks are a young team they return their top four scorers

including NAIA Honorable Mention All-American Steph Wisen.

In Pirnstill's first season, the V-Hawks finished 7–10–1 overall and 4–3–1 in conference play. The V-Hawks earned the third seed in the conference tournament but suffered a loss to the fourth seeded Ashford University.

Pirnstill was familiar with the V-Hawk program prior to taking over as head coach as he first served for Viterbo University as a men's team scout. From 2001–09 Pirnstill was the assistant coach for the Viterbo University women's program. Pirnstill also helped start the first Viterbo University Futsal program in the area which has grown to over 450 players.

During Pirnstill's time as an assistant, the V-Hawks won their first Midwest Collegiate Conference Championships in 2006 and 2007. The V-Hawks also advanced to the NAIA Region VII tournament both of those seasons including a trip to the regional final four in 2006.

Outside of Viterbo, Pirnstill has an extensive resume of playing and coaching experience. As a player, Pirnstill was selected to Wisconsin ODP U-16 and U-17 state teams and played club soccer with Racine United. He then went on to play at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse.

Pirnstill has an equally extensive coaching history. He has had an enormous impact on the development and growth of competitive soccer in the Coulee Region. Over the last 18 years he has compiled a diverse coaching resume including, Onalaska's Park and Recreation soccer program (U14 boys), Onalaska Soccer Club (U15 boys), Winona Youth Soccer Association Club (U14 girls), and CRM Lightning club (U14, 15, 16, 17 girls). During his four year stint coaching with CRM Lightning, Pirnstill's teams qualified for the state tournament four times, earning one second place finish and one state championship going undefeated the entire season and tournament. Pirnstill served as the director of coaching and player development for CRM Lightning from 2003–09.

In addition to coaching club soccer, he also served as a staff coach for the Olympic Development Program. He coached the 1991 Minnesota girl's pool team and has also participated as a Minnesota ODP District Select coach for four years.

Pirnstill coached high school soccer in the La Crosse area for three years as well. He coached the La Crosse Central boys JV (1994) and the West Salem High School girl's varsity team (2008–09).

Pirnstill has amassed an impressive list of coaching certifications and licenses. His qualifications include NSCAA National, Advanced National and Premier licenses. He holds NSCAA Goalkeeping Level I and II diplomas as well as various other NSCAA Special Topics diplomas.

Futsal Rules

- Number four sized ball—30 percent less bounce
- Five players
- Kick-in
- Unlimited “flying” sub (12 players on team)
- Stopped clock
- 20-minute halves
- One time-out per half
- Goal clearance (throw)
- No shoulder charges or sliding tackles
- Four-second rule on restarts
- No offside rule
- No restrictions, but limited to four seconds
- Five foul limit—no wall for direct free kick after fifth foul
- Goalkeeper cannot touch by hand a ball kicked back from teammate.
- One back pass to goalkeeper
- Player sent off can be substituted for after two minutes or other has scored

Supervision/Insurance

Participants will be supervised during competition by the Futsal league staff. It should be noted that all participants are expected to carry their own medical insurance. Viterbo will also provide an excess comprehensive medical insurance plan for participants. This plan covers all athletic-related accidents that your child may incur during competition subject to deductible and other conditions of the insurance plan.
